Marc Buyse is Chairman of IDDI Consultants in Louvain-la-Neuve, and Associate Professor of Biostatistics at Hasselt University in Belgium. He holds degrees in engineering and statistics from Brussels University (ULB), management from the Cranfield School of Management (Cranfield, UK) and a doctorate in biostatistics from Harvard University (Boston, MA). He was President of the International Society for Clinical Biostatistics, President of the Quetelet Society, and Fellow of the Society for Clinical Trials. He worked at the EORTC (European Organization for Research and Treatment of Cancer) in Brussels and at the Dana Farber Cancer Institute in Boston prior to founding IDDI (International Drug Development Institute) in 1991. He is interested in clinical trial methodology, meta-analysis, statistical detection of fraud, validation of biomarkers and surrogate endpoints, and drug development in oncology and ophthalmology.
