Stefan Michiels is currently at the Breast Cancer Translational Research Unit at the Jules Bordet Institute in Brussels, Belgium. His areas of expertise are statistical analysis of biomarker and genomic data, development and validation of prognostic models, clinical trials and meta-analyses. He acts as an independent statistical consultant for IDDI and occasionally as IDMC member. Stefan holds a PhD in Biostatistics from the School of Public Health at the Paris XI University and Master Degrees in Statistics and in Applied Mathematics from the University of Leuven. His previous positions included senior statistician at Solvay Pharmaceuticals (France, 2009), biostatistician at the Institut Gustave Roussy (France, 2002-2008), consultant at the National Cancer Institute (France, 2006-2007) and the University of Leuven (Belgium, 1998-2001). He is member of the editorial board for Biometrics, Cancer Prevention Research and performs regular statistical reviews for The Lancet journals.
